

About Santos GLNG

Santos GLNG is a pioneering venture that will produce natural gas from Queensland's coal seams and convert it into liquefied natural gas (LNG) for sale to world markets. It involves ongoing gas field development in the Surat and Bowen Basins, a 420-kilometre gas transmission pipeline, and the construction of an LNG plant on Curtis Island, near Gladstone.

Santos GLNG is led by Australian company Santos, in partnership with three of the world's leading energy companies – PETRONAS from Malaysia, Total from France, and KOGAS from South Korea.

Santos GLNG is on track to deliver its first LNG cargo in the second half of 2015 and, when fully operational, will have the capacity to produce 7.8 million tonnes of LNG each year. Santos GLNG is leading the way in making Australia a world-leading gas producer, and will contribute billions of dollars to the Queensland economy over many decades.



Fast facts

We have binding LNG sales agreements with PETRONAS and KOGAS for 7.2mtpa in aggregate.

Santos GLNG was sanctioned by its shareholders on 13 January 2011.

First LNG cargoes are scheduled to be exported in the second half of 2015.

We've invested \$200 million in social infrastructure and community sponsorships.

We have signed 850 land access agreements with more than 300 landholders.



Fuel for the future

- Santos has been producing natural gas in Queensland for more than 50 years and gas from coal seams for more than 16 years.
- Santos is working to build a future industry for Queensland, which is set to make the state one of the largest LNG exporters in the world.
- Natural gas, which is extracted from coal seams, is the cleanest of the fossil fuel alternatives.
- Gas is a low-emission alternative to coal when used to generate electricity.
- Over 90 per cent of all gas used in households throughout Queensland comes from coal seams.
- Gas extraction has a proven track record of co-existing with other land uses, in particular agriculture.
- Gas can be used to support the transition to renewable energy technologies.
- Liquefied natural gas, or LNG, is natural gas that has been cooled to -161 degrees Celsius, which significantly reduces its volume for transportation by ship to customers.
- LNG is colourless, odourless, non-toxic and does not mix with water or soil. It does not leave a residue and it disperses rapidly in the air.
- Exporting LNG to nearby markets in the Asia-Pacific lowers the region's greenhouse gas emissions.

Commitment to the environment

- We must meet stringent conditions as part of our environmental approval from the Queensland and Federal governments.
- We have a comprehensive water management strategy in place for our operations.
- We are implementing the most significant water monitoring programs in Australia to ensure we can detect any changes to surrounding environments early and manage potential impacts appropriately.

Growing local economies and delivering local benefits

- We've generated \$11.6 billion worth of work for Australian businesses, including \$6.2 billion in Queensland alone (between January 2011 and December 2013). This includes \$492.1 million in south-west Queensland and the Darling Downs region, and \$267 million in Central Queensland.
- We've invested \$200 million in social infrastructure and community sponsorships since Santos GLNG was first sanctioned.

Joint venture partners

We are a joint venture between:

- **Santos** — one of Australia's largest domestic gas producers;
 - **PETRONAS** — Malaysia's national oil and gas company and the world's second largest LNG exporter;
 - **Total** — the world's fifth largest, publicly traded integrated international oil and gas company; and
 - **KOGAS** — the world's largest LNG importer.
- The ownership structure is: **Santos 30%; PETRONAS 27.5%; Total 27.5%; and KOGAS 15%.**
